The Tom Bearson Foundation has created the Tom Bearson Foundation Scholarship Program to recognize the achievements, dedication, and efforts put forth by a Cathedral High School Senior student. We'll award one \$500 scholarship to any student who has been involved in varsity sports and plans to pursue a degree at a technical, 2-year, or 4-year post-secondary institution.

Criteria:

- Must have been a member of a Cathedral High School Varsity sports team in the last two years;
- Have an academic average of at least a C or above (not less than 2.00 on a 4.00 scale);
- Pursue a degree at a technical, 2-year, or 4-year post-secondary institution.

Purposes:

- To recognize scholastic and athletic achievement, and dedication to excellence;
- To acknowledge the hard work put forth by each student athlete;
- To encourage student athletes to continue their studies;
- To provide financial assistance.

Eligibility: *The applicant must:*

- Be a Cathedral High School senior in the Spring of 2019;
- Have an academic average of at least a C or above (not less than 2.00 on a 4.00 scale);
- Have been a member of a Cathedral High School Varsity sports team in the last two years.

Awarding of Scholarships:

- The Tom Bearson Foundation will award one \$500 scholarship;
- The scholarship recipient will be awarded the scholarship at Senior Awards Night;
- Scholarship awards are for one year and are not renewable.

To submit your application: present a copy of the completed application form and a personal essay by April 15, 2019. All documents must be submitted and postmarked no later than April 15, 2019 to the Tom Bearson Foundation Scholarship Coordinator (including inquiries):
